Fireworks in Hulmeville Borough

ireworks are dangerous! Even the smallest of fireworks, like a sparkler, can be up to 1200°f! First responders are asking that you are vigilant with your safety this summer and please do not set off fireworks. The Hulmeville Borough Police Department will be delivering flyers to each home this summer in an effort to warn of the dangers that can occur. Take the time to read up on the law before you purchase any items.

Seasonal Announcements

- -Comply with PA stormwater laws: Swimming pool water is not be emptied directly onto the sidewalks or roadways. It must run over 25' of soil area first before going into a water way. Do not have the water run directly into your neighbors property!
- -Keep our storm drains clean: Mowing season is in full swing! If grass clippings or leaves get into the roadways, they must be removed. Please direct your lawn maintenance companies of the same.
- -Reduce litter: Be courteous to your neighbors and curb your dogs.
- -Having a backyard bon-fire? Contact the Fire Marshall for the \$10.00 permit
- -Is your sewer vent level with the ground? Each vent should have a cap to prevent rain water from entering the system. Have questions? Send an email to hulmeville@comcast.net

New Water Meters Are Being Installed

Thank you to those residents who have already replied to the meter replacement calls/visits. Every water meter in the borough will be replaced. You will be notified and asked to schedule a time for your water meter to be replaced.

Proper Sump Pump Discharging stop discharging water into our sewers. Legally release the water to have it run over pervious ground (non-compacted soil in your yard) outside your home/business.

Stormwater Management

-All residents have been repeatedly informed of storing items in a floodplain. Hulmeville Borough residents are eligible for flood insurance by FEMA only if we, as a borough, comply with their standards. Anyone not complying will be held accountable for their actions. 
