Seasonal Announcements

- **Comply with PA stormwater laws:** Swimming pool water is not be emptied directly onto the sidewalks or roadways. It must run over 25' of soil area first before going into a water way. Do not have the water run directly into your neighbors property!
- **Keep our storm drains clean:** Mowing season is in full swing! If grass clippings or leaves get into the roadways, they must be removed. Please direct your lawn maintenance companies of the same.
- **Yard Waste Days** occur every week. Take advantage of this service for proper waste disposal.
- **High Water Events:** If you have questions about how to deal with extra water in your home, contact the Hulmeville Municipal Authority k.ludwig@hulmeville-pa.gov or 215-757-6531 x2.
- **Fireworks** are not entirely legal. Did you know you can not ignite them within 150' of any occupied structure? Visit the borough website for more safety information.
