-PA Dog Laws state that all dogs three months of age or older must be licensed. All dogs must be under control and must not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property, and owners are responsible for damages caused by their dog. More information can be found at:

The Fire Marshal is responsible for enforcement of the Borough fire code. This includes having an entertaining fire in your outdoor fire pit. 

- -Parking of vehicles on borough streets is prohibited during a snow event to allow for safe and efficient removal of snow (from 1 hour after snow begins to fall and until 12 hours after the snow ceases to fall).
