
By following us on social media you can stay up to date on the happenings around town and interact with your neighbors in these digital communities.

What's up with the trash pick-up you ask?

- On regular weeks, trash and recycling can be placed on your curb Tuesday evenings,

the night before collection. *Please pick up trash that has blown out of your secure bags & containers.* Areminder. During the holiday weeks of Memorial, 4th of July, Labor Day, Christmas, & New Year's, trash pick up will be on Thursday's (not the normal day of Wednesday). This is as per our waste service company, Leck.

Health & Safety



-The operation of an ATV on a public road or highway is still currently illegal under Title 75, <u>Section</u> <u>7721</u> and <u>7722</u>. The exception that allows for operation of ATVs during certain emergency situations requires the approval of the Department of Transportation and/or local authorities having jurisdiction. Neither the Department of Transportation nor any municipalities with jurisdiction have approved the use of ATVs on streets or highways.



As a reminder, ATV riding is only permitted on designated trails in Pennsylvania state forests. State forest roads, state parks, and state game lands are not open to ATV riding.


