Seasonal Announcements

-Christmas Trees (not bagged) will be picked up on January 10th & January 17th for proper recycling.

- -Parking of vehicles on borough streets is prohibited during a snow event to allow for safe and efficient removal of snow (from 1 hour after snow begins to fall and until 12 hours after the snow ceases to fall).
- -Fallen leaves & yard waste pick-ups continue to be a success in 2023 for those that properly disposed of their waste. Yard waste will resume in April of 2024. Please do not blow/sweep your leaves and grass clippings into the street. Dumping is prohibited throughout the borough.
